Veterans License Plates to Be Issued

The Virgin Islands Office of Veterans Affairs will be issuing license plates to those eligible Veterans who were not able to replace their original style VA plates. Plates will be issued at the office in your respective district on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8:30am to 12pm. Any Veteran seeking to complete this process will need to have a current DD214 on file at the office or bring one with you when coming. Please try to renew your license plates as soon as possible. In the very near future, the original VA license plates will no longer be an authorized license plate in the Virgin Islands.

Veterans wanting to register a newly imported vehicle must have proof of sales tax being paid in addition to eligibility documents in order to complete this process.

As a reminder, no more than 2 sets of license plates will be issued per Veteran.

NOTE: In order to continue safeguarding the lives of our Veterans, their families, and the staff of the Virgin Islands Office of Veterans Affairs, we are asking Veterans to adhere to the following days of issue:

- Last Name A-M on Mondays
- Last Name N-Z on Wednesdays
